- 1. Call meeting to order. The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Mark Wrona at 3:00p.m.

- **5. State of the lakes and progress report from Progressive.** Tony Groves of Progressive AE handed out Project Work Journals and discussed the weed treatments. Tony stated the lakes are high quality lakes.

• **Tri-Lakes Lake Improvement Board Special Assessments.** Sandy Brogan proposed one modification as follows to the 2021 Tri-Lakes Lake Improvement Board Special Assessments:

Add property 5411-057-036-000 (backlot w/ access; \$89.00); property was purchased from Land Bank and had not been assessed since 2015. This change resulted in the total properties assessed increased to 662 from 661 and the total assessment increased from \$90,010.15 to \$90,099.15.

M. Wrona moved with support from D. Lewis to accept the proposed assessment changes for the upcoming 2021 Special Assessment as reported above. Voted on, motion carried.

- Change 2021 Tri-Lakes Lake Improvement Board Special Assessment amount. Sandy Brogan pointed out that the balance in the assessment account in is at \$103,227.41 which will cover the upcoming bills. A discussion was held on the possibility of reducing the \$90,099.15 Special Assessment for 2021. *Moved by S. Brogan with support from M. Wrona to reduce the 2021 Assessment by 50%. Voted on, motion carried.*
